

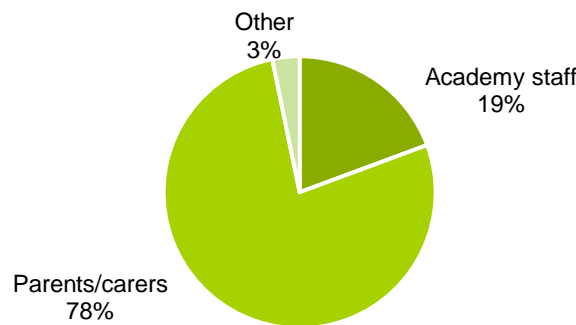
Executive Summary

Proposed Ormiston Cliff Park Infant and Junior Academies merger consultation

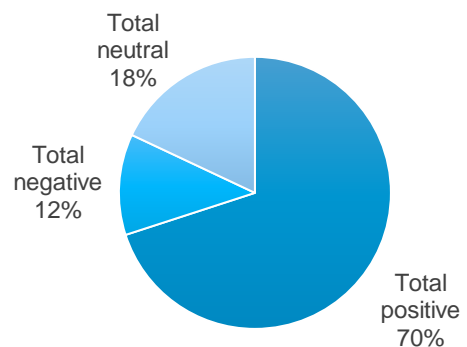
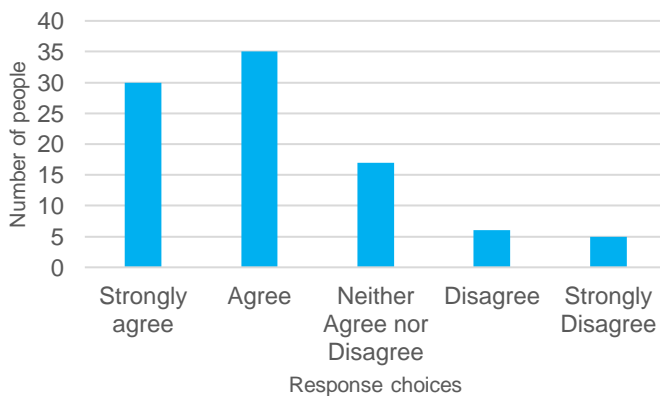
Thank you to everyone who provided responses during the consultation period and/or engaged with us through the stakeholder webinars. We very much value your feedback, suggestions and comments. All comments have been considered and answers to common questions can be found in FAQs [here](#).

From the responses received, an overall **majority of 70%** of stakeholders **support the proposed merger** and you can find more information about how stakeholders responded in the following sections. We will now move into the next phase of this project to undertake the necessary actions to complete the merger as smoothly as possible. From 1 September 2021 the two schools will be merged into one primary school known as *Ormiston Cliff Park Primary Academy*.

Who responded to the merger questionnaire?



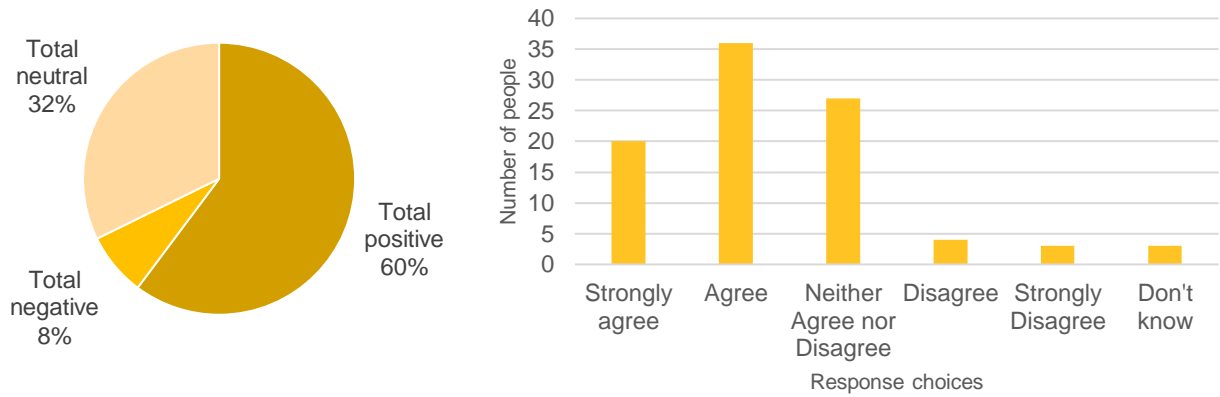
How far do you agree/disagree with the proposal to merge Cliff Park Infant and Junior Academies?



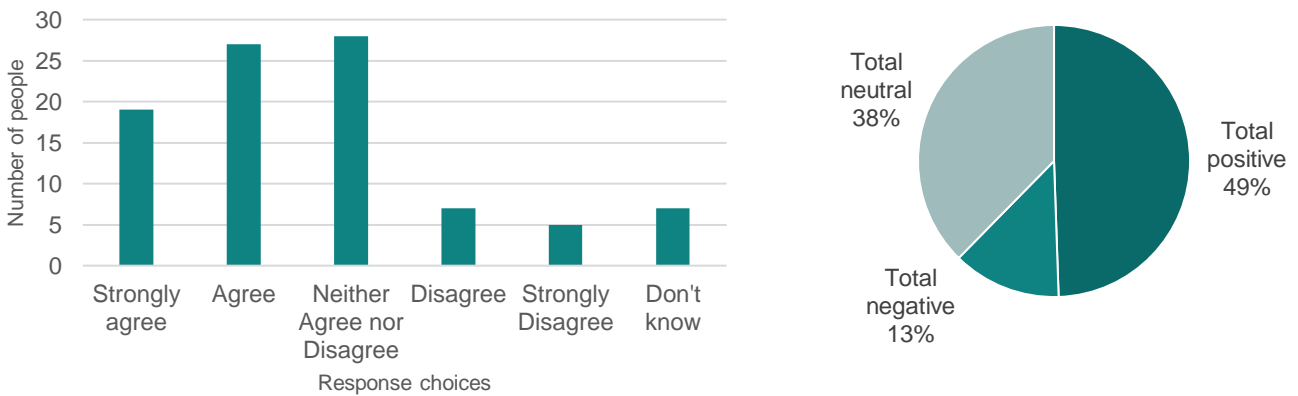
Some comments from stakeholders

- The schools both work alongside each other anyway being joined in one building I don't see that it will make much difference.

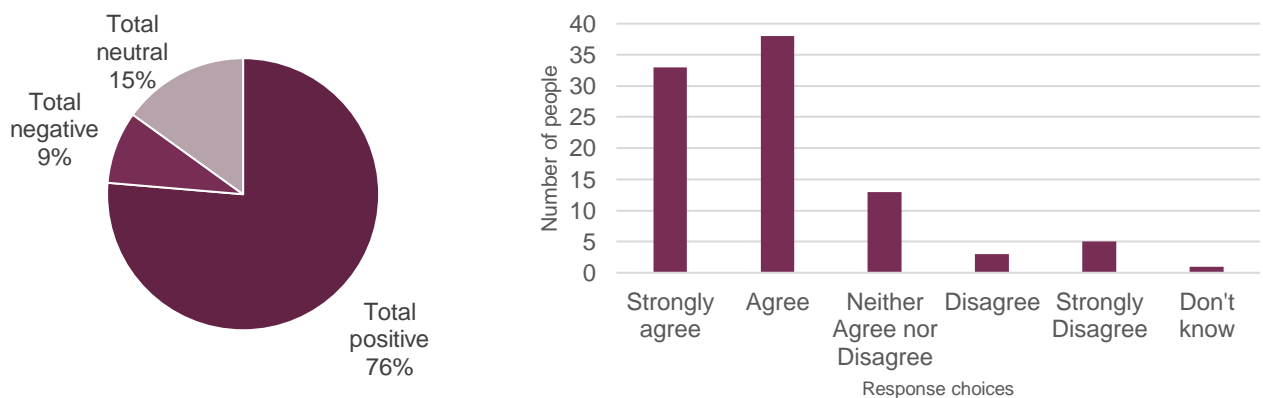
How far do you agree/disagree with the proposal to close the junior school and extend the age range of the infant school?
